BOARD POLICY

The Corporate Seal of the Board of Trustees, as redesigned in 1992, shall be used in all ordinary business transactions, such as conveyance of land, bond issuance documents, and other contracts made by the Board of Trustees, where a seal is required by law or the By-laws, or by special action of the Board of Trustees.

The seal of the Board of Trustees shall be used on all diplomas and certificates issued by the Board of Trustees to students and in certification of the fact of the granting of a degree, and may be used in all other academic matters where customary, requested or desirable.

The Secretary of the Board of Trustees is the official custodian of the Corporate Seal.
