NAME: Nebraska Access Program

POLICY
NUMBER: 3401

A. PURPOSE

To provide increased access for out-of-state graduate students, the Board authorized a special Nebraska Access tuition rate for qualifying non-resident graduate students seeking admission to and continuing enrollment at the State Colleges.

B. DEFINITIONS

C. POLICY

1. Entering Graduate Students

- 1.1. To qualify for the program, entering graduate students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 for all previous work attempted at all previous colleges attended.
- 1.2. To continue in the program, graduate students must maintain a 3.5 cumulative GPA.

2. Academic Partnership Program Students

- 2.1. All graduate students enrolled in an academic partnership program between one of the State Colleges and another institution will be eligible for the Nebraska Access Program when it is specifically referenced as a component of the agreement.
- 2.2. To continue in the program, students are required to maintain eligibility for enrollment.
