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#### INFORMATION ONLY: Fall Enrollment Reports


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The 2021 Fall enrollment reports provide the Board an overall picture of student enrollments across the Nebraska State Colleges. The report is based upon census data as of October 15th and is consistent with IPEDS submissions and definitions to the extent possible.

The Fall Enrollment report is intended to provide an overall picture of student enrollment across the Nebraska State Colleges. The report is based upon data as of October 15<sup>th</sup> and is consistent with IPEDs submissions and definitions to the extent possible. This report reflects only Fall 2021 enrollments and does not capture unduplicated enrollments for spring and summer terms.

#### Overall Enrollment

From 2020 to 2021, overall headcount increased by 4% and overall FTE has increased by 2%.




Decreases at CSC in both headcount and FTE were offset by increases at PSC of 2.2% in headcount and 3.9% in FTE and increases at WSC of 9% in headcount and 3% in FTE.

When compared to the 10-day enrollment numbers reported, final headcount was up for the system by 7% and final FTE was up 1%.

#### Retention

After experiencing an increase of 1% in overall retention rate from 70% in 2019 to 71% in 2020, the system has seen a 3% decrease in retention from 2020 to 2021 to 68%. CSC and WSC experienced decreases of 1% and 2%, respectively. However, PSC saw a 5.5% decrease. It is important to note in the 2021 report, The Condition of Education, the retention rate for public

open admissions 4-year institutions from 2018 to 2019 was only 61%, and the data reported represent a period that does not include the pandemic.



### Professional Development


In July 2021, the Board approved a new tuition rate for professional development courses. Professional Development students are those students who are enrolled and receiving credit in a training, continuing education, and/or professional development activity offered by external organization or entity. During the fall 2021, CSC offered only undergraduate level professional development with a total headcount of 37. PSC did not offer any professional development courses. WSC offered only graduate level professional development with a total headcount 35.

This information will be incorporated into future fall enrollment reports in the total enrollment section in a similar fashion to dual credit.

### Residency

Residents are those students whose state of residence is listed as Nebraska. Non-Residents include any students whose state of residence is listed as any state other than Nebraska as well as all international students.


The overall percentage of resident students increased from 74% to 75% from 2020 to 2021. Of the total undergraduate students, the percentage of resident students showed a slight increase of 1% from 75% to 76%. The percentage of graduate students who are residents increased by 2%, from approximately 71% in 2020 to 73% in 2021.



## Delivery

With respect to the delivery of courses, students may be duplicated if they are taking a course in more than one delivery type. The number of on-campus students includes those students who are taking at least one credit on campus. The number of online students includes those students who are taking at least one online course, regardless of other course enrollment, that requires the students to participate and interact with one another and with their instructors online.

The overall distribution of students taking courses on campus and online has experienced a change. In 2020, 60% of students were taking at least one course on campus and 49% of students were taking at least one online course. In 2021, 60% of students were taking at least one course on campus and 54% were taking at least one online course. Approximately 85% of graduate students are taking at least one online course while a smaller but still significant percentage of undergraduate students (51%) take at least one online course.
