Posthumous Degrees

POLICY

3601 NUMBER:

#### A. PURPOSE

To establish the requirements for the granting of a posthumous degree to a deceased student.

### B. <u>DEFINITIONS</u>

None

#### C. POLICY

#### 1. Eligibility

AThe Colleges may have the discretion to, at the request of the immediate family of a deceased student and at the discretion of the college's administration upon the recommendation of the faculty of the college, award a posthumous degree if the following conditions are met. Aat the time of his/herthe student's death, or at the time of withdrawal from the College due to medical necessity relating to a terminal illness, the student:

- Was enrolled in a degree bearing program and in good standing at the College; and
- Had attained senior status.

#### 2. Procedure

#### 2.1. **Timeline**

- The posthumously awarded degree shall be granted upon the request of immediate family for the term in which the degree would have been earned had the student been able to complete the courses for which he/shethe student was registered.
- The request for decision to conferral of a posthumous degree must be presented tomade by the College of the student's attendance within two years of the death of the student.

#### 2.2. Notification Process

- Prior to the granting of a posthumous degree, the President shall notify the Chancellor of plants to note the degree in the commencement program for the first terms after approval of the posthumous award or the term for which the degree is awarded, whichever is later.
- The degree posting becomes a permanent entry on the student's transcript.
