***ACTION:* First and Final Round Approval of Revisions to Board Policy
3510; Health Services**

Revisions to Board Policy 3510 require the Colleges to include within their respective health service programs education, awareness and support with respect to physical health, mental health, general wellness, and drug and alcohol education. Additionally, it expressly requires the provision of counseling services and mental health resources.

POLICY NUMBER: 3510

A. PURPOSE

To outline the scope of the State Colleges' responsibilities regarding the provision of a health service program for students.

B. DEFINITIONS

C. POLICY

1. **Scope of Responsibility**

Each College will provide a health service program for students including education, awareness and support in such areas as physical health, mental health, general wellness, and drug and alcohol education.

Each College will also provide counseling services and mental health resources for the purpose of promoting students' physical and mental well-being.

2. **Funding**

The programs shall be financed-supported by established health fees and other appropriate charges.
