ACTION: First and Final Round Approval of Board Policy 9006; Utility Support of Auxiliary System

Policy 9006 - Utility Support of Auxiliary System is a new policy. The ability to pay for heat, power and other utilities for the Auxiliary System using Cash or State appropriated dollars was previously referenced in policy 9005, but it has now been moved to this policy to make it easier to find. The format of the policy is also updated, but there are no substantive changes.

The policy has been reviewed by the appropriate councils and legal counsel.

The System Office recommends approval of the Board Policy 9006; Utility Support of Auxiliary System.

Auxiliary System

POLICY NAME: Utility Support of Auxiliary System

POLICY NUMBER: 9006

A. PURPOSE

To allow for the payment of Auxiliary System utilities expenses using non-system funds.

B. DEFINITIONS

1. **Auxiliary System** – Facilities comprised of housing facilities, buildings and structures used for athletic and wellness purposes, student centers, medical centers and parking facilities that are pledged under a bond resolution.

C. POLICY

Payment of Utilities

The Board may, at its discretion, furnish heat, light, power and other similar utilities for the Auxiliary System revenue bond facilities without charging the same against the revenues thereof.

1.1. Board Approval

The Colleges must get Board approval before covering the utilities with cash or state appropriated funds.
