Established in 1867, the Nebraska State College System (NSCS) consists of the three state colleges; Chadron State, Peru State and Wayne State. The State Colleges offer several programs to keep a four-year degree affordable:

### • Career Scholarships

Offers State College students to attain their degrees at an affordable cost while also providing career experience through internships and other experiential learning opportunities. Scholarships can range from \$2,000 - \$15,000 per year that can cover tuition, fees, room, and board expenses. The scholarship is renewable for up to four years for students who remain eligible.

### • State College Guarantee

With our Tuition Guarantee program, if you qualify for a Pell Grant, you **will not pay tuition** at Chadron State, Peru State, or Wayne State.




### • Free Application

It is **ALWAYS** free to apply to Chadron State, Peru State, and Wayne State Colleges.
