<b>Meals</b>	\$2,628 per semester	\$5,256 per year
<b>Total</b>	\$8,999 per semester	\$17,998 per year

## Career Scholarships

You may be eligible for a Career Scholarship if you have an ACT score of 18+ (or equivalent score on other standard college admissions tests) and are a student in Business Administration, Communication Arts, Education, Justice Studies, or Rangeland Management.





## Tuition Guarantee

The Nebraska State College Guarantee ensures that Pell-eligible students, or students with a family income of \$65,000 or less, are guaranteed free tuition.

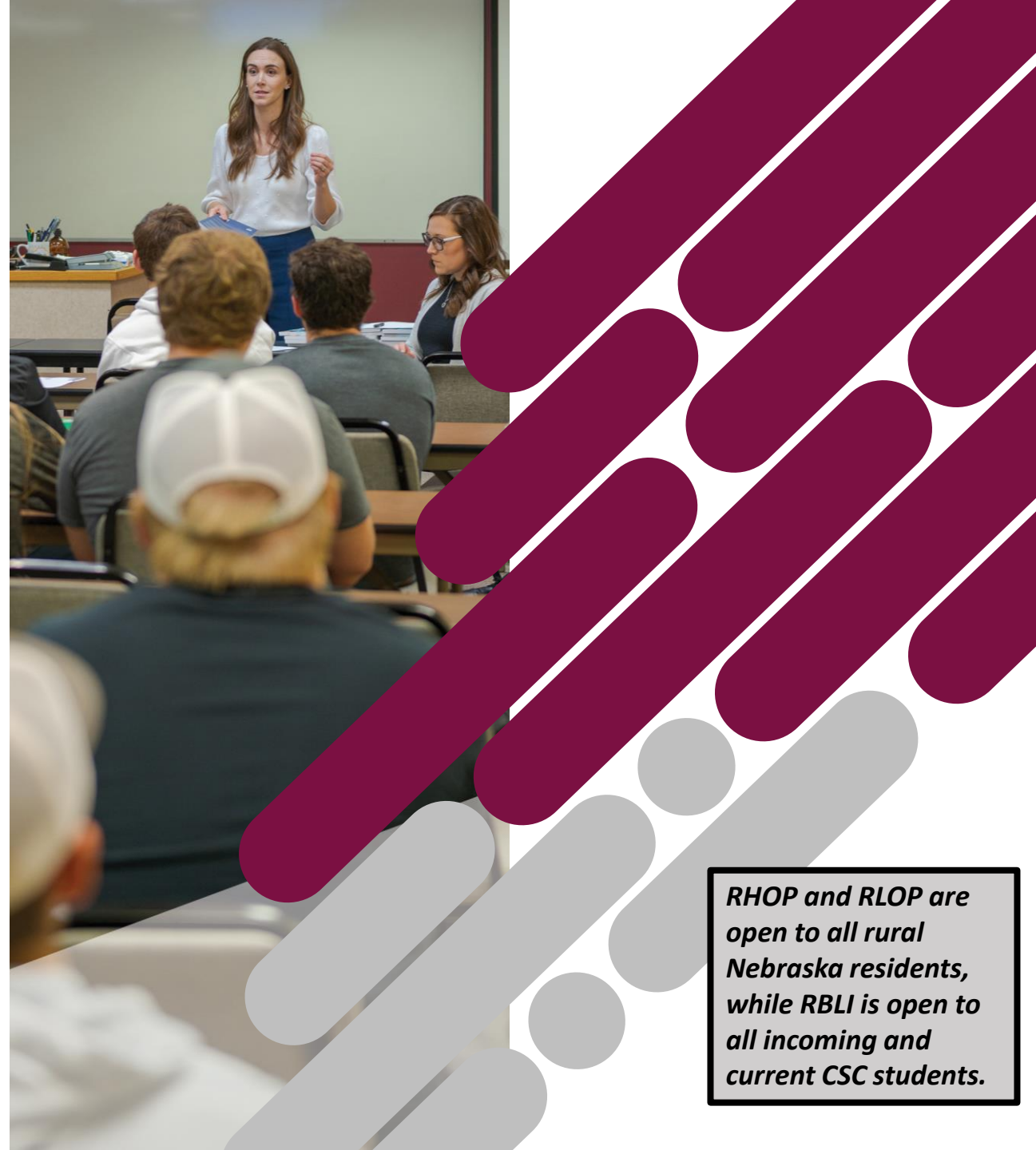

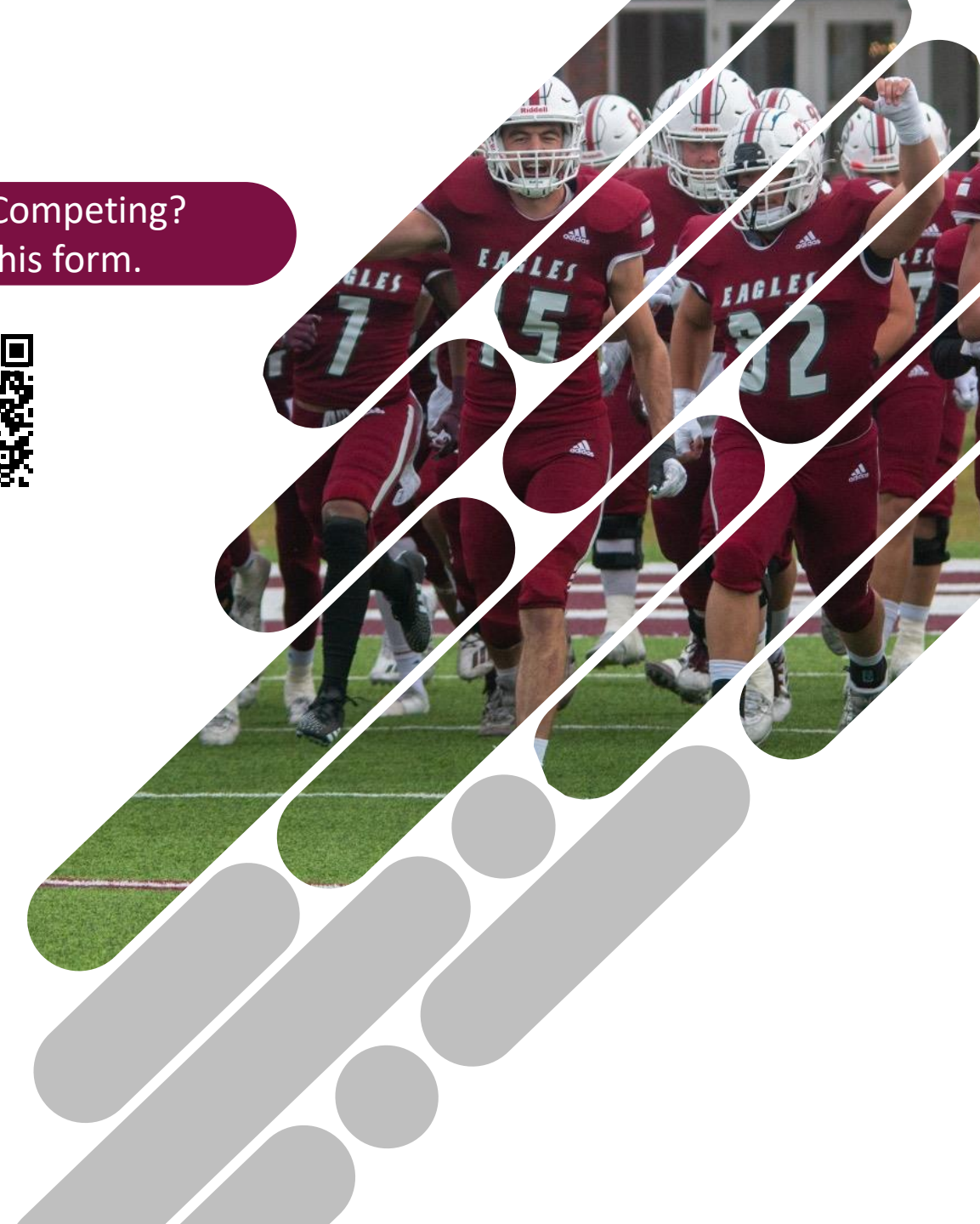
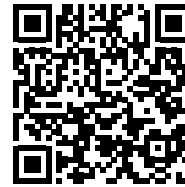
